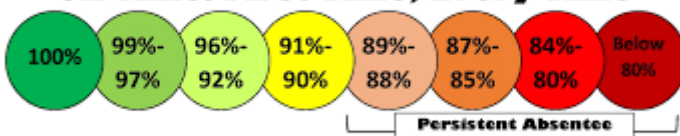
100% Attendance Trip
