Outdoor Challenges



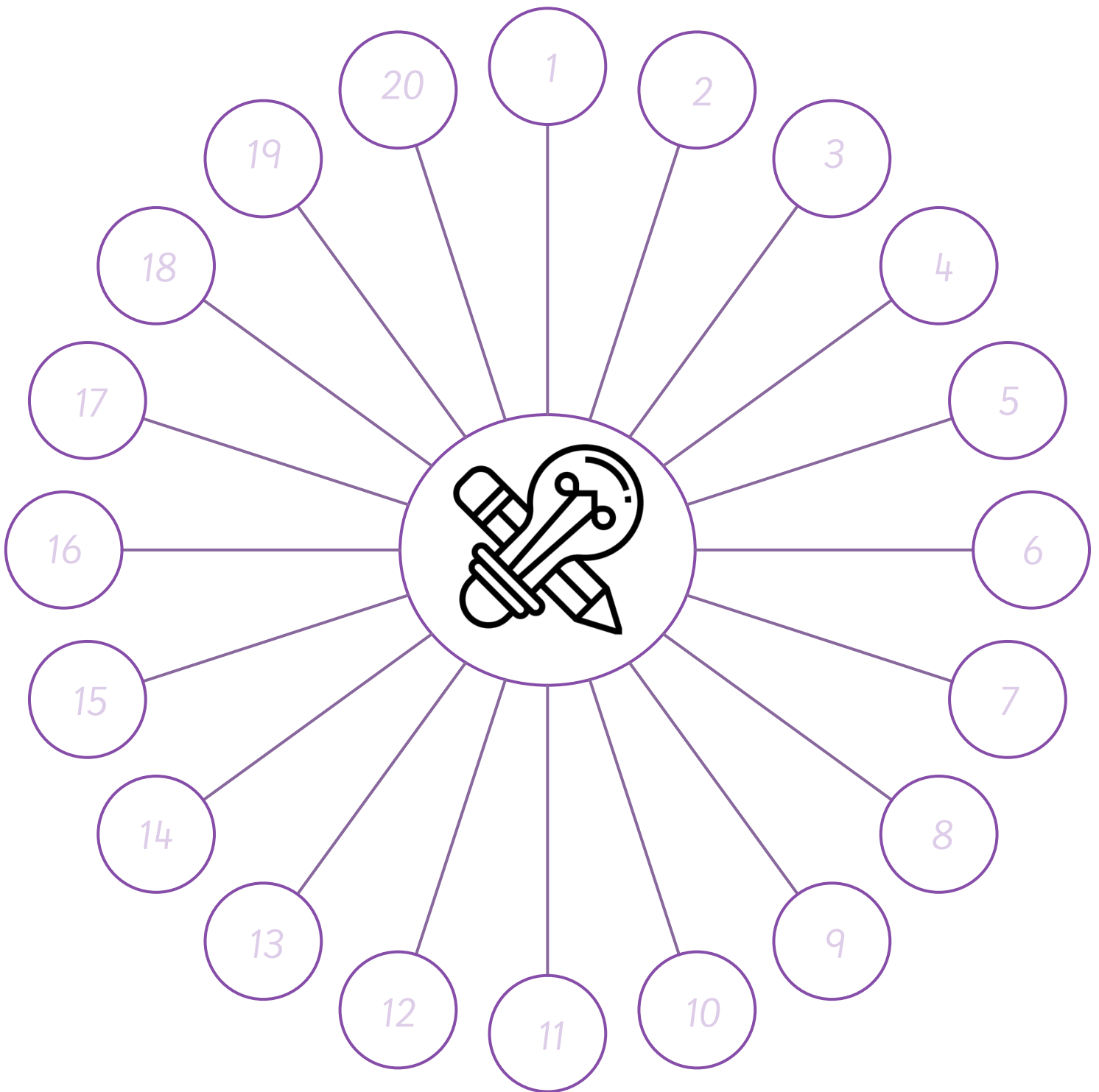
1. Design and make a den.

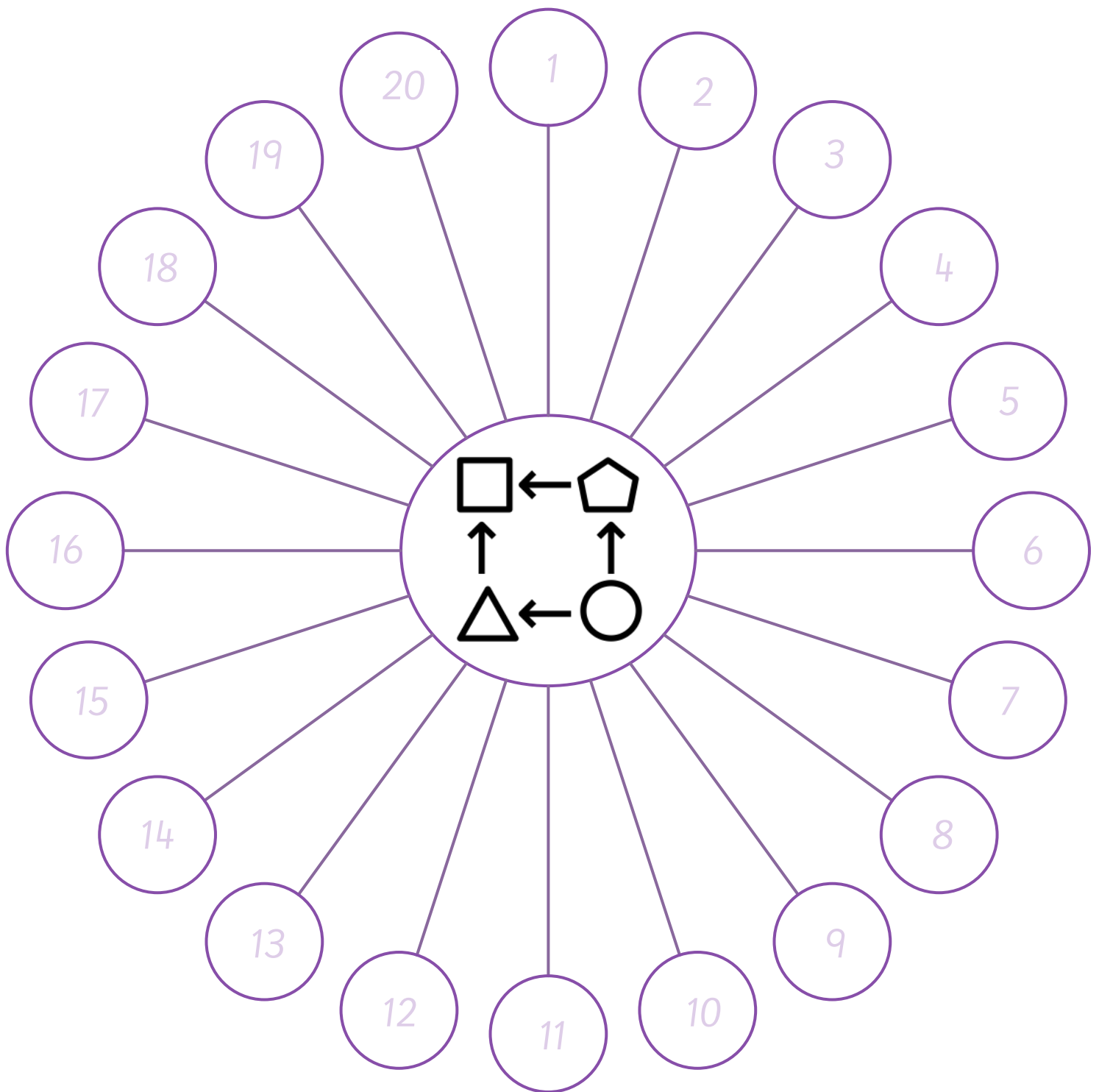
1. Know who your local MP is and understand their role.

Creative Arts



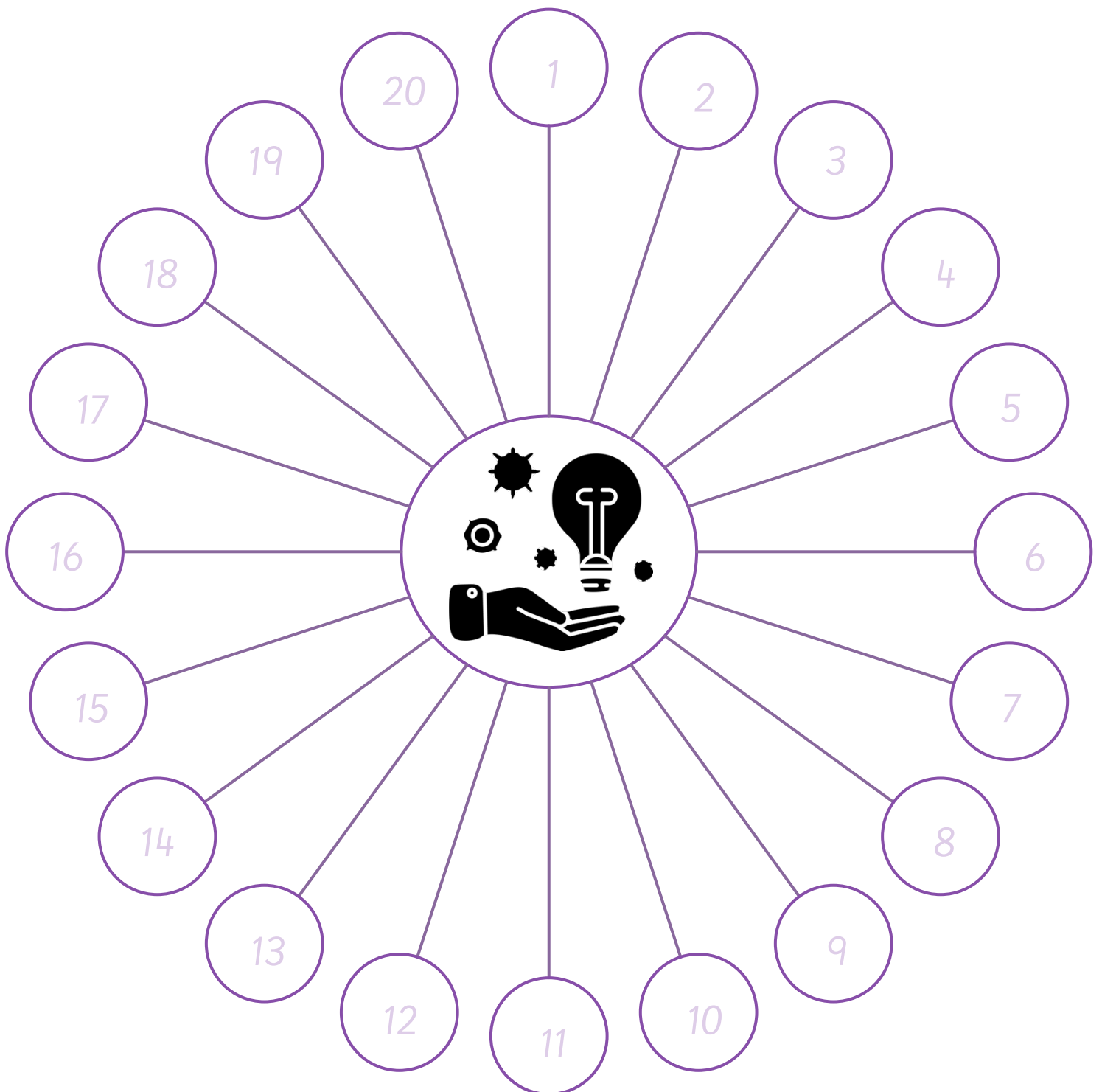
1. Visit the theatre to watch a performance.

20. Go on a zipwire.

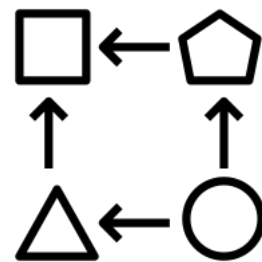
