INSPIRE Curriculum Support for SEND: MFL



In MFL children with SEND are supported by quality first teaching using a range of strategies from our Teaching and Learning Toolkit and Walkthrus. We believe that all children are entitled to an education which meets their individual needs and our curriculum is differentiated to ensure all children make progress and learn more. Specific strategies are used in MFL lessons to support children with SEND as detailed below.

Physical and Sensory Needs

Chunking steps in learning

Walk and talk model answers – modelling how to access appropriate support

Encourage children to take their time to come up with the correct answer, using appropriate support

Social and Emotional Needs

Wide variety of activities across all 4 skills – not just focussed on written production

Appropriate seating for encouraging peer support

Use of mini w/b, vrai/faux cards

Cognition and Learning

Images used when introducing new vocabulary – helps children to remember

Lessons chunked to enable introduction, practice, reinforcement, application of learning

Using a range of activities and tasks

Explicit retrieval tasks and questioning to explore this further

Communication and Interaction

Access to KO at home for prelearning/embedding

Talk partners and collaborative working encouraged
