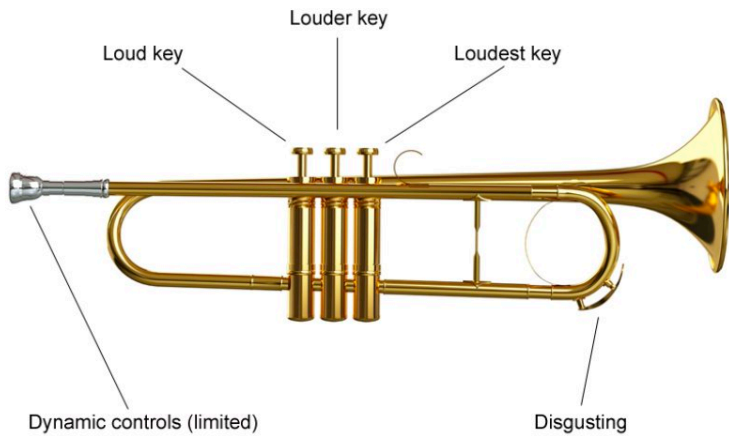
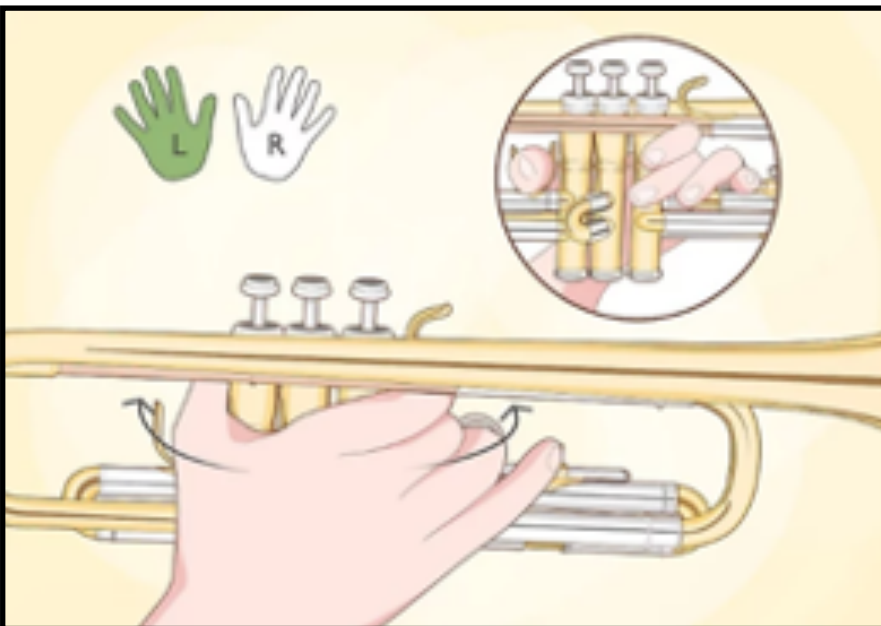




Year 5 Brass



How to hold your instrument



Vocabulary

trumpet	A brass musical instrument with a flared bell and a bright, penetrating tone.
brass	A musical instrument that you play by blowing through a mouthpiece to change the pitch, or note.
mouthpiece	The part that you blow into make a sound.
rhythm	The pattern of long and short notes.
rhythmic patterns	Anything that has some kind of a pulse that can be repeated. For example, counting "one, two, one, two, one, two..." is a rhythmic pattern using words.
pulse	The underlying steady beat of music. This is what we may tap our foot to or clap along with. It's the 'heartbeat' of the song'
tempo	The speed of the music.
pitch	How high or how low a sound is.
melody	A sequence of notes or rhythms
dynamics	The variation in loudness between notes or phrases.
texture	Layers of sound.
structure	The way the music is built up.
